Admissions Requirements

- Must have graduated from a regionally or nationally accredited high school, passed a high school level proficiency test, or have documented home school completion (please see Basis for Admissions policy for more information about home school documentation).
- Applicants who have prior College Level credits must have a transfer GPA of 2.0 from institutional accretor approved by the US Department of Education.
- Applicants who have prior College Level credits with a transfer GPA below 2.0 may be admitted under Probationary Admission.

Transfer Credit Requirements
